- c) Ensuring that all PTj provide the location requirements of the centralisation, security aspects, and other requirements before the procurement is verified.
- d) To verify the procurement applications for valuable ICT hardware and software from all PTj:
 - i. Ensuring that all PTj provide the location requirements of the centralisation, security aspects and other requirements before the procurement is verified.
 - ii. Procurement for research purposes using *Tuntutan*Bayaran Balik Wang Sendiri (TBWS), the value of which

requires JPPTM verification, should refer the

treasurer's circular bill 1/2018 guidelines for TBWS

e) To report the progress of each approved/recommended

procurement to the University ICT Committee.

f) Disseminating information on the latest ICT issues to all PTj.

software that can be used as reference and guidelines by all PTj

when preparing procurement documents and is updated from

time to time according to technological developments.
